## Script

It all started when they discovered huge benefits coming from crude oil production.

Used in every aspect of human activity from transportation through industry to production overwhelmed all Earth. Besides pollution urge to control resources caused wars and sustained postcolonial inequalities among societies.

Devastating influence of plastic on life chain was proven. This material not only contaminates in its complete form as objects but also when smaller particles are released from it. Plastic can continue to divide into even smaller fractions, almost to infinity. Nanoplastics, up to a billionth of a meter, can pass through all human tissues, travel through the bloodstream and reach the brain.

Galleria Mellonella inhabits now entire world. Its habitats are cosy and very sound resistant due to the fact the species is very sound fragile. Beside thick walls most of the individuals do not use windows or cover them during the day time.

Larva feeds on plastic specifically polyethylene. Caterpillar range in size from 3 to 30 m long, and are white or dirty gray color. At the moment population of Galleria Mellonella is eating approximately 1000 tones of plastic material a day. The global production of plastics rose to 348 million tonnes in 2017, with the majority being single-use convenience products that eventually end up littering environment.

Human industrialization grew to enormously even to incredibly high overproduction. Through out time there were some prophetic artists that predicted shortage of the food supplies to come among earth population. Andy Warhol popularized possessing canned soups in ones home rather in big quantities. On the contrary, Polish artist Natalia LL proposed the idea to suck and lick before you taste, to obtain greater satisfaction from what one actually consumes.

Biologic documentaries narrator describes life of the caterpillar until the cocoon stage. Slow voice following what caterpillar is doing.

At the end row of cocooned caterpillars scary in the amount. This temporary stage.. What is gonna to happen? Did they accomplish the task to save other organisms from being plastic contaminated ?
